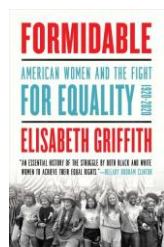
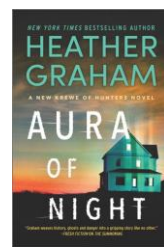
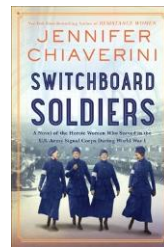
Ashplain Players to perform at
