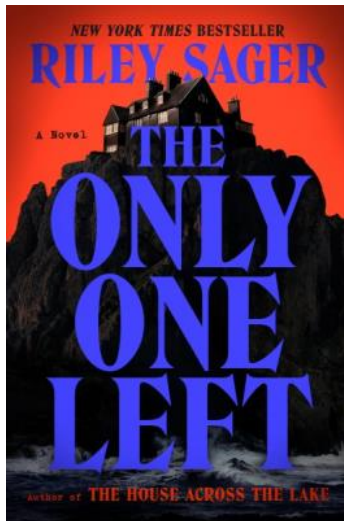

We meet on the last Tuesday of each month. Stop by the library, check out a copy of the book and come to our next meeting!



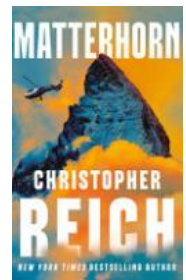
## Free Delivery
