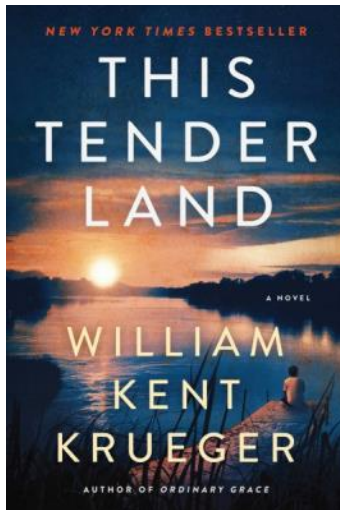

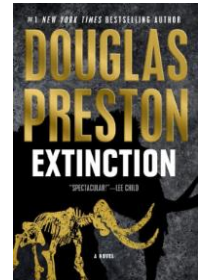
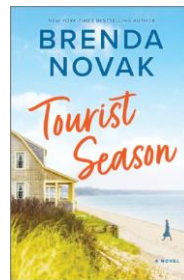
Free Delivery
